Harbor Seal



blubber to keep warm, large eyes and whiskers to help find food

Otter



Really thick fur to keep warm, strong teeth to eat hard animals, pockets in armpits

laying in the shallow water to warm up in the sun

Blow bubbles into their fur to keep them warm, using rocks to break open food, otter mom teaching their young how to hunt

exoskeleton (shell)

Use their claws to dig crab condos
